

Petition to the executive of the Green Party of Alberta (Alberta Greens):

Whereas geographic distance is a major factor prohibiting full involvement of the membership in physical meetings, and
Whereas the membership should serve as final adjudicator in matters having such significance for the future of the party,

We the undersigned members of the Green Party of Alberta call on the party executive to:

- 1) Convene a General Meeting per the party constitution as it stood prior to September 27, 2008, and that such meeting address the full business that was to be attended to at the Annual General Meeting, including the regular election of executive positions and consideration of directive and constitutional motions submitted prior to the September 27 meeting date, and
- 2) Ensure opportunity for the entire party membership to participate in the decisions of the General Meeting, regardless of geographical location, by offering mail-in ballots for all matters to be decided at the Meeting,
- 3) Additionally, for those motions which would trigger an immediate vote should they pass, submit amendments proposing that those motions be altered to have such vote(s) be conducted by mail-in ballot to be mailed out to the full membership of the party within one week of such motion passing.
